The Woodward-Granger Foundation Board is composed of members from our local community, in partnership with school administration. This team works together to identify and meet needs for student enrichment.



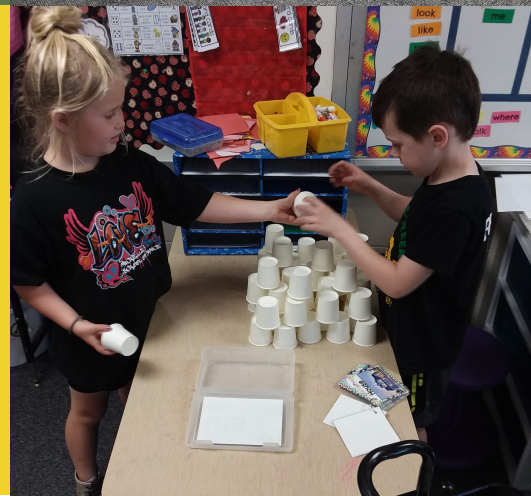
Our History
